### Call for trainees - Stay Human!



April 2016 – September 2016 | NL, LT, IT, RO

#### Description

In this call you will find more information about the Stay Human project and your role as a trainee. The entire Stay Human! programme will take part in 4 different European countries; Romania, Italy, Lithuania & the Netherlands. We chose topics for the youth exchanges that have a strong link with our identity as organizations. This enables us to connect the youth exchanges to topics of importance in our local societies. The youth exchange in Lithuania has LGBT+ rights as a theme, the exchange in Italy is all about migrant rights, while the youth exchange in Romania will focus on youth and children rights. Underneath you will find an overview of the Stay Human! Human Rights Education programme.

This programme offers place to 118 young people to gain a whole new experience in the field of Human Rights (HR). To the training course we invite 2 trainees per youth exchange, from which one is a more experienced group leader. We believe that for support in a group it's essential that there are two equally trained people who can support each other in the same national group. The participants of the

- ★ Increase your knowledge, skills and attitude in the field of Human Rights education and in 1 of the 3 topics of the youth exchanges; LGBT+ rights, Migrant rights and Children & Youth rights;
- ★ Empower yourself and other young people to become responsible citizens, educators and advocates for human rights;
- ★ Create awareness among young people about Human Rights and stimulate them to take an active role in promoting & advocating these rights in their local realities;



- ★ Become a Human Rights educator in your own local reality.

## Requirements

- ★ You are between the age of 18-30 and you are interested in HR;
- ★ You have more than a basic level of English;
- ★ You are available to take part in the training course, 1 of the 3 youth exchanges and its APV and you are present during the evaluation meeting.

## Trainee, would you like to

- ★ Create new experiences, skills and connections in the field of HRE and in 1 of the 3 topics of the youth exchanges; LGBT+ rights, Migrant rights or Children & Youth rights;
- ★ Within a very beautiful and inspiring environment;
- ★ Implement the gained competences in favor of your community and beyond, to share and disseminate HR values!
- ★ Prepare a programme of a youth exchange with your peer cross-cultural trainees together with the hosting organization;
- ★ Prepare and equip the youth groups that you will take to the youth exchange, together with your national colleague trainee;
- ★ Or anything else? We are open to all your ideas that can contribute to a grand human rights programme! So if you for example need to do research or develop specific competences for your formal education don't hesitate to integrate this in the programme!

## Practical information

As a trainee you are present in the crash course (training), and in an advanced planning visit (APV) and a Youth Exchange of your choice; and the Evaluation Meeting.

This multi measure project consists of 8 different mobility activities:

- 1: Crash course Stay Human! Human Rights education in the Netherlands - April 2016
- 2: Advanced planning visit LGBT+ youth exchange in Lithuania - May 2016
- 3: Youth exchange LGBT+ rights in Lithuania - June 2016
- 4: Advanced planning visit Migrant rights in Italy - June 2016
- 5: Youth exchange Migrant rights in Italy - July 2016
- 6: Advanced planning visit Children & youth rights in Romania - July 2016
- 7: Youth exchange Children & youth rights in Romania - August 2016
- 8: Evaluation meeting Stay Human! programme in The Netherlands – August 2016
